

# Gross misconduct hearing: Chief Constable Nick Adderley

In accordance with Regulation 36 of the Police Conduct Regulations we are required to publish the following information:

A Gross Misconduct disciplinary hearing, chaired by Legally Qualified Chair Mr Callum Cowx, will be held by Northamptonshire Police Fire and Crime Commissioner at the Northampton Saints ground between 28<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> May 2024, starting at 10 am.

The Chief Constable is the subject of the hearing.

Mr Adderley faces gross misconduct allegations to the effect that he has *inter alia* exaggerated the rank, duration and achievements in his service with the Royal Navy and implied that he served in the Falklands War in breach of several standards of professional behaviour.

Home Office Guidance; Police Officer Misconduct Procedures 2020, states:

- The person chairing the Hearing may impose conditions
- The Chair may exclude from the hearing any person whose behaviour, in their opinion, is likely to disrupt the orderly conduct of proceedings
